REVIEW OF POLICY FOR LOW CARBON PRECINCTS

Snapshot

Recent low carbon precincts will be used as case studies to identify and demonstrate design considerations, building elements, policy, social and financial considerations that have played a role in the development of successful precincts.

Outcome

The scoping paper will identify a range of low carbon precinct principles and benchmarks that have been successfully used nationally and internationally for low carbon initiatives. Articulation of these principles would allow them to be readily used in Australian projects either through adoption as policy within government or as selection criteria for briefs within the development sector.
