EDUCATION SCOPING STUDY

Snapshot

This study surveyed CRC members' experience of low carbon education and found that more widespread, collaborative communication of information about low carbon built environments and their costs and savings is necessary for informed decisions to be made.

Outcome

The report identifies the key areas that could be improved so that various stakeholders have a common understanding of issues involved with creating a low carbon built environment. The scoping study will support the CRC's Program 3: Engaged Communities, year one milestone 3.4. A survey and gap analysis of existing low carbon education and training programs of selected CRC precincts.
